- Applicants will be notified by the 15th of the following month.
- Submitted projects/ideas must support the school *EPSS* and standards-based curriculum.
- Applicants may receive **one grant per academic year**.
- In the interest of disbursing funds to all clusters and quadrants of the city, **a school may only receive up to two (2) grants per month and not more than 6 grants per school year**. Only Albuquerque Public School teachers are eligible.
